5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 417 West 7th Street in Colum-
7 bia, Tennessee, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Pharmacist’s Mate First Class John Harlan Willis Post
2 Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Pharmacist’s Mate
7 First Class John Harlan Willis Post Office Building”.

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
