To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to require codes on the labels of tobacco products for the purpose of tracking or tracing the tobacco product through the distribution system.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tobacco Tracking, Re-
5 porting, and Accountability for Compliance in Enforce-
6 ment Act” or the “Tobacco TRACE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TOBACCO PRODUCT CODES FOR TRACKING OR**
2 **TRACING.**

3 Section 920(b)(3) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
4 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 387t(b)(3)) is amended by strik-
5 ing “The Secretary may” and inserting “Beginning not
6 later than June 1, 2026, the Secretary shall”.
