A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Adminis-
tration to report on certain costs of tariffs, and for
other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trump Tariff Trans-
5 parency Act”

6 **SEC. 2. QUARTERLY REPORT ON CERTAIN COSTS OF TAR-**
7 **IFFS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
9 date of the enactment of this Act, and quarterly there-
10 after, the Administrator of the Small Business Adminis-

1 tration, in consultation with the Director of the Bureau
2 of Economic Analysis, shall make publicly available a re-
3 port on the average aggregate cost of tariffs imposed after
4 January 20, 2025, to consumers and small business con-
5 cerns (as defined in section 3 of the Small Business Act
6 (15 U.S.C. 632)).

7 (b) FINAL REPORT.—The final quarterly report re-
8 quired under subsection (a) for a calendar year shall in-
9 clude the total annual cost of such tariffs to consumers
10 and small business concerns.

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
