A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “The Disaster Recovery
5 Efficiency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPLEMENTATION OF GAO RECOMMENDATIONS.**

2 The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-
3 agement Agency and the Secretary of Housing and Urban
4 Development shall take such actions as may be necessary
5 to implement the priority recommendations of the Comp-
6 troller General of the United States contained in the re-
7 port published on November 15, 2022, and titled “Dis-
8 aster Recovery: Actions Needed to Improve the Federal
9 Approach” (GAO–23–104956).

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
