Mr. McCORMICK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Export Control Reform Act of 2018 relating
to the review of the interagency dispute resolution process.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Export Dispute Reso-
5 lution Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REVIEW OF INTERAGENCY DISPUTE RESOLUTION**
7 **PROCESS.**

8 Section 1763(c) of the Export Control Reform Act
9 of 2018 (50 U.S.C. 4822(c)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “In any case” and inserting the
2 following:

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—In any case”;

4 (2) by inserting “countries subject to a com-
5 prehensive United States arms embargo,” after
6 “matters relating to”;

7 (3) by striking “may be decided” and inserting
8 “shall be decided”;

9 (4) by adding at the end the following: “The
10 chair of the Committee is authorized to decide any
11 case or matter described in the preceding sentence
12 in which the Committee is unable to decide the case
13 or matter by majority vote.”; and

14 (5) by further adding at the end the following:

15 “(2) DEFINITION.—In paragraph (1), the term
16 ‘country subject to a comprehensive United States
17 arms embargo’ means—

18 “(A) any country listed on table 1 to para-
19 graph (d)(1) of section 126.1 of title 22, Code
20 of Federal Regulations (as such section is in ef-
21 fect on the day before the date of the enact-
22 ment of this paragraph); and

23 “(B) the Russian Federation.”.
