A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to schedule synthetic 7-hydroxymitragynine as a Schedule I controlled substance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Needless Distribu-
5 tion of 7-OH Act” or the “END 7-OH Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SCHEDULING OF 7-HYDROXYMITRAGYNINE.**

7 Schedule I, as set forth in section 202(c) of the Con-
8 trolled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 812(c)), is amended by

1 adding at the end of subsection (b) of such schedule the
2 following:

3 “(23) 7-hydroxymitragynine—

4 “(A) including its synthetic equivalents;

5 but

6 “(B) not including 7-hydroxymitragynine

7 naturally contained in the plant of the genus

8 and species name: *Mitragyna speciosa* Korth,

9 also known as kratom.”.

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
