A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to amend regulations relating to exemptions for engines and equipment for purposes of national security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Responders’
5 Equipment Access Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS EXEMPTING EN-**
2 **GINES/EQUIPMENT FOR NATIONAL SECU-**
3 **RITY.**

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
5 of this Act, the Administrator of the Environmental Pro-
6 tection Agency shall revise the regulations under section
7 1068.225(d) of title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (as
8 in effect on the date of enactment of this Act)—

9 (1) to authorize—

10 (A) manufacturers and secondary engine
11 manufacturers to request a national security ex-
12 emption under such section 1068.225(d) for en-
13 gines or equipment intended to be used by Fed-
14 eral, State, or local agencies for providing law
15 enforcement, disaster relief, search and rescue,
16 fire response, or emergency medical services;
17 and

18 (B) an agency of the Federal Government
19 responsible for national defense and the De-
20 partment of Homeland Security (including the
21 Federal Emergency Management Agency) to
22 endorse a request described in subparagraph
23 (A); and

24 (2) to specify that a request for a national secu-
25 rity exemption described in paragraph (1)(A), and
26 an endorsement of such a request described in para-

- 1 graph (1)(B), is not required to specify a quantity
- 2 of engines or equipment to be exempted in order to
- 3 receive such an exemption.
