A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to provide for priority consideration for certain grants for applicants who have entered into section 287(g) agreements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Incentivizing Coopera-
5 tion in Immigration Enforcement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRIORITY CONSIDERATION FOR CERTAIN GRANT**
2 **APPLICANTS.**

3 Section 1701(c) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
4 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10381(c)) is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) in paragraph (2)(C), by striking “or” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking the period
9 and inserting “; or”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(4) from an applicant in a State, or a political
12 subdivision of a State, that has entered into a writ-
13 ten agreement with the Secretary of Homeland Se-
14 curity pursuant to section 287(g) of the Immigration
15 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1357(g)).”.
