A BILL

To repeal the Executive order entitled “Ensuring a National Policy Framework for Artificial Intelligence”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Guaranteeing and Up-
3 holding Americans’ Right to Decide Responsible AI Laws
4 and Standards Act” or as the “GUARDRAILS Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDER.**

6 The Executive order entitled “Ensuring a National
7 Policy Framework for Artificial Intelligence”, issued on
8 December 11, 2025, shall have no force or effect, and no
9 Federal funds may be used to implement, administer, en-
10 force, or carry out that Executive order.

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
