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## A BILL

To direct owners and operators of gas distribution pipeline facilities to assess systems for the presence of Aldyl-A polyethylene, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Future  
5       Vintage Plastic Pipeline Tragedies Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ALDYL-A PIPELINES.**

2 (a) ASSESSMENT OF ALDYL-A POLYETHYLENE PIP-  
3 ING.—Not later than 3 years after the date of enactment  
4 of this Act, each owner or operator of a gas distribution  
5 pipeline facility shall assess its system for the presence  
6 of Aldyl-A polyethylene.

7 (b) LIMITATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall not re-  
9 quire owners and operators of gas distribution pipe-  
10 line facilities to conduct excavation activities for the  
11 purpose of the assessment required under subsection  
12 (a).

13 (2) SAVINGS PROVISION.—Nothing in this sub-  
14 section affects the authority of the Secretary  
15 under—

16 (A) section 60112 of title 49, United  
17 States Code; or

18 (B) subsection (m) or (p) of section 60117  
19 of that title.

20 (c) REPORTING.—Not later than 3 years after the  
21 date of enactment of this Act, each owner or operator of  
22 a pipeline facility described in subsection (a) shall submit  
23 to the Secretary the estimated total pipeline mileage iden-  
24 tified by the owner or operator as Aldyl-A polyethylene  
25 piping.

1 (d) STATE PIPELINE SAFETY PROGRAM CERTIFI-  
 2 CATIONS.—Section 60105(b)(9)(A) of title 49, United  
 3 States Code, is amended by striking “of cast iron and bare  
 4 steel pipelines” and inserting the following: “of—

5 “(i) cast iron and bare steel pipelines;  
 6 and  
 7 “(ii) pipelines constructed of historic  
 8 plastics with known safety issues”.

9 (e) EVALUATION OF RISK IN DISTRIBUTION INTEG-  
 10 RITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.—Section  
 11 60109(e)(7)(A)(i) of title 49, United States Code, is  
 12 amended by striking “presence of cast iron pipes and  
 13 mains in the distribution system; and” and inserting the  
 14 following: “presence, in the distribution system, of pipes  
 15 and mains made of—

16 “(I) cast iron;  
 17 “(II) unprotected steel;  
 18 “(III) wrought iron; or  
 19 “(IV) historic plastics with  
 20 known safety issues; and”.

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
