Mr. GREEN of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To amend the Defense Production Act of 1950 to require the Defense Production Act Committee to conduct discussion-based simulations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening and Im-
5 proving Mobilization Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISCUSSION-BASED SIMULATIONS.**

7 Title III of the Defense Production Act of 1950 (50
8 U.S.C. 4531 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
9 the following:

1 **“SEC. 306. DISCUSSION-BASED SIMULATIONS.**

2 “‘At least once every 5 years, the Defense Production
3 Act Committee shall conduct a discussion-based simula-
4 tion (commonly known as a ‘table-top exercise’) to deter-
5 mine the resources needed and the best use of the authori-
6 ties under title I and this title.’”.

7 **SEC. 3. SHORT TITLE CORRECTION.**

8 The first undesignated section of the the Defense
9 Production Act of 1950 is amended, effective on the date
10 of enactment of such Act, by striking “‘cited as “the De-
11 fense”” and inserting “‘cited as the “Defense””.

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
