A BILL

To amend the Foreign Agents Registration Act to require certain disclosures on informational materials, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Propaganda
5 Transparency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE.**

7 Section 4(b) of the Foreign Agents Registration Act
8 of 1938, as amended (22 U.S.C. 614(b)) is amended by
9 adding after “Columbia.” the following new sentence,

1 “The conspicuous statement shall also detail, where appli-
2 cable, whether the foreign principal is supervised, directed,
3 owned, controlled, financed, or subsidized, in whole or in
4 part, by: a covered nation as defined in section 4872(f)(2)
5 of title 10, United States Code, or any other foreign gov-
6 ernment acting on behalf of, at the direction of, under the
7 control of, or for the benefit of such a covered nation.”
