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## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to expand certain remote monitoring services furnished by physicians to individuals with end stage renal disease under the Medicare program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

### 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Individuals  
5 with Dialysis Needs Equipped through Year-round Re-

1 mote Monitoring Act” or the “KIDNEY Remote Moni-  
2 toring Act”.

3 **SEC. 2. EXPANDING CERTAIN REMOTE MONITORING SERV-**  
4 **ICES FURNISHED BY PHYSICIANS TO INDIVID-**  
5 **UALS WITH END STAGE RENAL DISEASE.**

6 Section 1881(b)(3) of the Social Security Act (42  
7 U.S.C. 1395rr(b)(3)) is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by striking “sub-  
9 paragraph (B)” and inserting “subparagraphs (B)  
10 and (C)”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
12 paragraph:

13 “(C) For purposes of subparagraph (A), payment for  
14 remote physiologic monitoring services furnished by a phy-  
15 sician on or after January 1, 2028, to an individual deter-  
16 mined to have end stage renal disease receiving home di-  
17 alysis shall be made on the basis described in section  
18 1848.”.

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
