Mrs. CHERFILUS-McCORMICK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Workforce

A BILL

To prohibit Federal education funds from being made available to any educational agency or institution that releases any education records or other student information for purposes of immigration enforcement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep Immigration En-
5 forcement Out of Schools Act” or the “No ICE in Schools
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF RELEASE OF EDUCATION**
2 **RECORDS OR OTHER STUDENT INFORMA-**
3 **TION FOR IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT**
4 **PURPOSES.**

5 Section 444 of the General Education Provisions Act
6 (20 U.S.C. 1232g) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following:

8 “(k) Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-
9 tion, no funds shall be made available under any applicable
10 program to any educational agency or institution which,
11 for purposes of immigration enforcement, has a policy or
12 practice of releasing, or providing access to—

13 “(1) any education records; or

14 “(2) any other information with respect to a
15 student, including personally identifiable information
16 or directory information,

17 unless there is written consent from the student’s parents
18 specifying the records or information to be released, the
19 reasons for such release, and to whom, and with a copy
20 of the records or information to be released to the stu-
21 dent’s parents and the student if desired by the parents.”.

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
