Ms. LETLOW introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To prohibit the provision of Federal funds to organizations that promote jury nullification, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Rogue Jurors Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FEDERAL FUNDS FOR ORGANIZA-**
6 **TIONS THAT PROMOTE JURY NULLIFICATION.**

7 No Federal funds may be used to provide a grant,
8 contract, award, or any other form of financial assistance
9 to any organization, school, or entity that conducts train-
10 ing, produces materials, or engages in outreach (including

1 under the title or framework of “Equity & Root Cause
2 Jury Training” or any substantially similar designation)
3 for the purpose of encouraging individuals to seek jury
4 service in any Federal or District of Columbia court pro-
5 ceeding with the intent to vote contrary to the evidence
6 or applicable law, including promoting the deliberate act
7 of voting to acquit a defendant regardless of whether the
8 elements of the charged offense have been established
9 (commonly referred to as “jury nullification”).

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
