3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF REID VAPOR PRESSURE REQUIRE-**
4 **MENTS WITH RESPECT TO CALENDAR YEAR**
5 **2026.**

6 (a) WAIVER.—Notwithstanding any other provision
7 of law, with respect to the period beginning on May 1,
8 2026, and ending on September 15, 2026, the Adminis-

1 trator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall waive
2 the prohibition under section 211(h) of the Clean Air Act
3 (42 U.S.C. 7545(h)) on the sale, offering for sale, dis-
4 pensing, supply, offering for supply, transport, and intro-
5 duction into commerce of gasoline the Reid Vapor Pres-
6 sure of which exceeds the applicable standard.

7 (b) APPLICABLE STANDARD DEFINED.—In this sec-
8 tion, the term “applicable standard” has the meaning
9 given such term in section 80.27(a)(2) of title 40, Code
10 of Federal Regulations, or any successor regulation.

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
