A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop performance metrics relating to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of fentanyl.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This act may be cited as the “Measuring Illicit
5 Fentanyl Trafficking Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMBATTING ILLICIT FENTANYL.**

7 Not later than one year after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security
9 shall—

1 (1) ensure that each component of the Depart-
2 ment of Homeland Security engaged in the detec-
3 tion, deterrence, and seizure of fentanyl—

4 (A) collaborate and share relevant informa-
5 tion and data relating to the detection, deter-
6 rence, and seizure of fentanyl with other compo-
7 nents of the Department of Homeland Security
8 engaged in such detection, deterrence, and sei-
9 zure; and

10 (B) identify any barriers to sharing rel-
11 evant information and data pursuant to para-
12 graph (1); and

13 (2) establish performance metrics relating to
14 the detection, deterrence, and seizure of fentanyl for
15 the Department of Homeland Security and each
16 component of such Department.

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
