A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop performance metrics relating to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of fentanyl.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This act may be cited as the “Measuring Illicit*
5 *Fentanyl Trafficking Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. COMBATTING ILLICIT FENTANYL.**

7 *Not later than one year after the date of the enactment*
8 *of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall—*

9 *(1) ensure that each component of the Depart-*
10 *ment of Homeland Security engaged in the detection,*
11 *deterrence, and seizure of illicit fentanyl—*

12 *(A) to the extent practicable, collaborate*
13 *and share relevant information and data relat-*
14 *ing to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of il-*
15 *licit fentanyl with other components of the De-*
16 *partment of Homeland Security engaged in such*
17 *detection, deterrence, and seizure or the measure-*
18 *ment thereof; and*

19 *(B) identify any barriers to sharing rel-*
20 *evant information and data pursuant to para-*
21 *graph (1); and*

22 *(2) establish performance metrics relating to the*
23 *detection, deterrence, and seizure of illicit fentanyl for*
24 *the Department of Homeland Security and each com-*
25 *ponent of such Department and ensure that such*

- 1 *metrics align with any strategic objectives and goals*
- 2 *of the Department related to the efforts of the Depart-*
- 3 *ment to combat illicit fentanyl trafficking.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop performance metrics relating to the detection, deterrence, and seizure of illicit fentanyl, and for other purposes.”.

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
