A BILL

To amend the Indian Health Care Improvement Act to modify the notification requirement for emergency contract health services for certain beneficiaries, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indian Health Service
5 Emergency Claims Parity Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY CONTRACT**
7 **HEALTH SERVICES.**

8 Section 406 of the Indian Health Care Improvement
9 Act (25 U.S.C. 1646) is amended—

10 (1) by striking “With respect to” and inserting
11 the following:

12 “(b) ELDERLY OR DISABLED INDIANS.—With re-
13 spect to”; and

14 (2) by inserting before subsection (b) (as so
15 designated) the following:

16 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
17 (b), with respect to an Indian receiving emergency medical
18 care or services from a non-Service provider or in a non-
19 Service facility under the authority of this Act, the time
20 limitation (as a condition of payment) for notifying the
21 Service of such treatment or admission shall not be less
22 than 15 days.”.
