A BILL

To require certain entities carrying out certain projects relating to the construction, reopening, and improvement of facilities to display certain public safety notices, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Truck Stop Safety
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBLE**
2 **PROJECTS.**

3 Section 1401 of MAP-21 (23 U.S.C. 137 note) is
4 amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
6 section (f); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(e) **PUBLIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBLE**
10 **PROJECTS.**—An entity carrying out a project to construct,
11 reopen, or improve facilities under this section shall ensure
12 that—

13 “(1) a notice containing information about
14 human trafficking and resources to prevent and re-
15 port human trafficking is prominently displayed in
16 such facility, including the National Human Traf-
17 ficking Hotline, a clear definition of human traf-
18 ficking, and warning signs of human trafficking; and

19 “(2) a notice containing information about sui-
20 cide prevention is prominently displayed in such fa-
21 cility, including information on the 988 Suicide and
22 Crisis Lifeline that explains any call, text, or chat to
23 988 is free, confidential, and available 24/7.”.
