A BILL

To sunset the Advisory Committee on the Records of
Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Advisory Committee on*
 5 *the Records of Congress Sunset Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. MANAGEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF THE**
 7 **RECORDS OF CONGRESS.**

8 (a) *SUNSET OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE*
 9 *RECORDS OF CONGRESS.—Effective on the date that is 60*
 10 *days after the date of the enactment of this Act, title 44,*
 11 *United States Code, is amended—*

12 (1) *by striking chapter 27; and*

13 (2) *in the table of chapters, by striking the item*
 14 *relating to chapter 27.*

15 (b) *REPORT.—Not later than February 1 of the year*
 16 *beginning after the date of enactment of this Act, and annu-*
 17 *ally thereafter, the Director shall submit a report on the*
 18 *management and preservation of the records of Congress*
 19 *during the previous year to—*

20 (1) *the Archivist;*

21 (2) *the Secretary;*

22 (3) *the Clerk;*

23 (4) *the Committee on Homeland Security and*
 24 *Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Rules*
 25 *and Administration of the Senate; and*

1 (5) *the Committee on Oversight and Government*
 2 *Reform and the Committee on House Administration*
 3 *of the House of Representatives.*

4 (c) *REVIEW.*—*The Archivist, the Secretary, and the*
 5 *Clerk shall meet to review the management and preserva-*
 6 *tion of the records of Congress—*

7 (1) *not later than 60 days after the date on*
 8 *which the Director submits a report under subsection*
 9 *(b); and*

10 (2) *not later than 180 days after the date on*
 11 *which an individual begins to carry out the duties*
 12 *and responsibilities of the Archivist, Secretary, or*
 13 *Clerk.*

14 (d) *DEFINITIONS.*—*In this section:*

15 (1) *ARCHIVIST.*—*The term “Archivist” means*
 16 *the Archivist of the United States, or any successor*
 17 *thereto.*

18 (2) *CLERK.*—*The term “Clerk” means the Clerk*
 19 *of the House of Representatives.*

20 (3) *DIRECTOR.*—*The term “Director” means the*
 21 *Director of the Center for Legislative Archives of the*
 22 *National Archives, or any successor thereto.*

23 (4) *SECRETARY.*—*The term “Secretary” means*
 24 *the Secretary of the Senate.*

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
