A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

5 *Protection Act of 2026”.*

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF EFFECTIVENESS OF CERTAIN REGU-**
7 **LATIONS CONCERNING NORTH ATLANTIC**
8 **RIGHT WHALE.**

9 *Section 101 of division JJ of the Consolidated Appro-*
10 *priations Act, 2023 (16 U.S.C. 1387 note) is amended by*
11 *striking “2028” each place it appears and inserting*
12 *“2035”.*

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
