3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Unlocking Next-Gen-
5 eration Licensing and Opportunities for Collaborative
6 Know-how for AUKUS Act” or the “UNLOCK AUKUS
7 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF LIMITATION RELATING TO EX-**
2 **PORTS AND TRANSFERS OF DEFENSE ARTI-**
3 **CLES AND SERVICES UNDER THE AUKUS**
4 **PARTNERSHIP.**
