Ms. OMAR introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee
on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To require the Department of State to consult with Congress
on Islamophobia in Europe.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Europe
5 from Islamophobia Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONSULTATIONS ON ISLAMOPHOBIA IN EUROPE.**

7 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
8 gress that—

9 (1) the Assistant Secretary for European and
10 Eurasian Affairs, in consultation with other relevant

1 officials of the Department of State, should assess
2 the persistent and growing threat of Islamophobia in
3 Europe as a matter of importance to the foreign pol-
4 icy of the United States; and

5 (2) the Under Secretary for Political Affairs,
6 acting through the Assistant Secretary for European
7 and Eurasian Affairs, should diplomatically engage
8 governments of countries of apparent concern on ef-
9 forts for transatlantic cooperation to counter and
10 address Islamophobia that may threaten trans-
11 atlantic stability, the safety and security of United
12 States citizens, and institutions abroad.

13 (b) CONSULTATION.—Not later than 180 days after
14 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
15 after for two years, the Assistant Secretary for European
16 and Eurasian Affairs shall consult with the appropriate
17 congressional committees on the matters described in sub-
18 section (a).

19 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
20 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
21 sional committees” means—

22 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
23 House of Representatives; and

- 1 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the
- 2 Senate.
