A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Promoting Access and
5 Revenue Integrity Through Institutional Transparency
6 Act” or the “PARITY Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. REGULATORY RELIEF.**

8 Section 487 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
9 U.S.C. 1094) is amended—

- 1 (1) in subsection (a), by repealing paragraph
- 2 (24); and
- 3 (2) by repealing subsection (d).
