Mr. MCGUIRE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To direct the Director of the Bureau of Prisons to provide medication assisted treatment for opioid addiction to certain women.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Maternal Access to
5 Treatment Act of 2026” or the “MAT Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT.**

7 (a) REQUIREMENT.—The Director of the Bureau of
8 Prisons shall provide medication assisted treatment (com-
9 monly known as “MAT”) to each pregnant woman in the
10 custody of the Bureau of Prisons addicted to opioids.

1 (b) EXCEPTION.—A pregnant woman who is mentally
2 competent may deny the provision of medication assisted
3 treatment under subsection (a).

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
