To amend the Commodity Credit Corporation Charter Act
with respect to funding and assistance under such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defend American Agri-
5 culture Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FUNDING AND ASSISTANCE UNDER THE COM-**
7 **MODITY CREDIT CORPORATION CHARTER**
8 **ACT.**

9 Section 4(i) of the Commodity Credit Corporation
10 Charter Act (15 U.S.C. 714b(i)) is amended by striking

1 “shall not at any time exceed in the aggregate
2 \$30,000,000,000.” and inserting “shall not exceed in the
3 aggregate \$45,000,000,000 for the period beginning on
4 the date of the enactment of the Defend American Agri-
5 culture Act through September 30, 2031, and shall not
6 at any time after September 30, 2031, exceed in the ag-
7 gregate \$30,000,000,000.”.

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
