A BILL

To provide supplemental appropriations for certain programs of the Administration for Children and Families, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Daycare Not Deten-
5 tions Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
3 GRANTS.—In addition to amounts otherwise available,
4 there is appropriated, out of any funds in the Treasury
5 not otherwise appropriated, \$25,500,000,000, to remain
6 available through fiscal year 2029, to the Administration
7 for Children and Families within the Department of
8 Health and Human Services, for necessary expenses in
9 carrying out the Child Care and Development Block Grant
10 Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 9857 et seq.).

11 (b) CHILD CARE ENTITLEMENT TO STATES.—In ad-
12 dition to amounts otherwise available, there is appro-
13 priated, out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise
14 appropriated, \$20,000,000,000, to remain available
15 through fiscal year 2029, to the Administration for Chil-
16 dren and Families within the Department of Health and
17 Human Services, for necessary expenses in carrying out
18 section 418 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 618).

19 (c) HEAD START.—In addition to amounts otherwise
20 available, there is appropriated, out of any funds in the
21 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$24,000,000,000, to
22 remain available through fiscal year 2029, to the Adminis-
23 tration for Children and Families within the Department
24 of Health and Human Services, for necessary expenses in
25 carrying out the Head Start Act (42 U.S.C. 9801 et seq.).

1 (d) PRESCHOOL DEVELOPMENT GRANTS.—In addi-
2 tion to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated,
3 out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
4 priated, \$500,000,000, to remain available through fiscal
5 year 2029, to the Administration for Children and Fami-
6 lies within the Department of Health and Human Serv-
7 ices, for necessary expenses in carrying out section 9212
8 of the Every Student Succeeds Act (42 U.S.C. 9831 note).

9 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION.**

10 Of the amounts appropriated or otherwise made
11 available by the Secure America Act (Public Law 119–
12 98) for U.S. Customs and Border Protection and U.S. Im-
13 migration and Customs Enforcement that remain unobli-
14 gated on the date of enactment of this Act,
15 \$70,000,000,000 are hereby rescinded.

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
