Mr. FINE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to establish birth tourism as an offense, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Deliveries Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. BIRTHING MISREPRESENTATIONS.**

6 Section 1546 of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a)—

9 (A) by striking “or fact—” and inserting

10 “or fact; or”;

1 (B) by inserting before “Shall be fined”
2 the following: “

3 “Whoever knowingly enters the United States
4 for the purpose of giving birth to a child whose par-
5 ents are not nationals or lawful permanent residents
6 of the United States and misrepresents such pur-
7 pose—”; and

8 (C) by inserting “not less than 10 years (if
9 the offense resulted in such child being born in
10 the United States) or” before “not more than
11 25”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
14 United States district court shall have jurisdiction to enter
15 a judicial order of removal at the time of sentencing
16 against any alien who is convicted of an offense under this
17 section.”.

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
