Mr. PERRY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Homeland Security from waiving or reducing any fee associated with an application for United States citizenship.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Discounts for For-

5 eigners Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN FEE WAIVERS AND RE-**
7 **DUCTIONS.**

8 (a) PROHIBITION.—Except as provided for under
9 subsection (b), the Secretary of Homeland Security may

1 not waive or reduce any fee associated with an application
2 for United States citizenship.

3 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection
4 (a) shall not apply to an application submitted pursuant
5 to section 328 or section 329 of the Immigration and Na-
6 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1439; 1440) by a member of the
7 Armed Forces or an alien who previously served as a mem-
8 ber of the Armed Forces.

9 (c) ARMED FORCES DEFINED.—In this section, the
10 term “Armed Forces” shall have the meaning given such
11 term in section 101 of title 10, United States Code.

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
