Mr. AUSTIN SCOTT of Georgia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To prohibit certain commercial activities with respect to certain South Atlantic red snapper during certain periods, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “South Atlantic Red
5 Snapper Fair Access Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

8 (1) South Atlantic red snapper is a healthy
9 public fishery resource that supports recreational an-
10 glers, for-hire operators, coastal communities, fish-

1 ing tackle retailers, marinas, restaurants, lodging
2 providers, and other businesses throughout the
3 South Atlantic region.

4 (2) In recent years, recreational harvest of
5 South Atlantic red snapper in Federal waters has
6 been limited to extremely short seasons, including
7 one- and two-day seasons, despite historic abundance
8 and strong public demand for access to the fishery.

9 (3) Conversely, commercial harvest of South At-
10 lantic red snapper in Federal waters has remained
11 open for substantially longer periods, including com-
12 mercial seasons that have lasted for weeks or
13 months in recent years.

14 (4) Leading up to the 2026 recreational fishing
15 season, the States of Florida, Georgia, South Caro-
16 lina, and North Carolina, working with the National
17 Marine Fisheries Service, developed and received ap-
18 proval for State-led exempted fishing permit pilot
19 programs designed to improve recreational fisheries
20 data collection, test State management strategies,
21 reduce uncertainty, and provide more reasonable rec-
22 reational access to South Atlantic red snapper.

23 (5) Those State-led pilot programs were halted
24 by a preliminary injunction issued by the United
25 States District Court for the District of Columbia,

1 blocking the approved 2026 pilot seasons for the
 2 States of Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, and
 3 North Carolina, including Florida's season just
 4 hours before it was scheduled to begin.

5 (6) While anglers continue to sit at the dock
 6 awaiting a management system that allows reason-
 7 able access to a healthy public fishery resource, con-
 8 servation burdens and access restrictions should be
 9 shared fairly across sectors.

10 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN COMMERCIAL ACTIVI-**
 11 **TIES WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN SOUTH AT-**
 12 **LANTIC RED SNAPPER DURING CERTAIN PE-**
 13 **RIODS.**

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—It is unlawful for any person, for
 15 commercial purposes—

16 (1) to harvest any South Atlantic red snapper
 17 from Federal waters during a covered period; or

18 (2) to sell, purchase, trade, barter, or offer for
 19 sale any South Atlantic red snapper harvested from
 20 Federal waters during a covered period.

21 (b) PENALTIES.—

22 (1) IN GENERAL.—An act described in sub-
 23 section (a) shall be treated as an act described in
 24 section 307 of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Con-
 25 servation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1857) for

1 purposes of sections 308 through 311 of that Act
2 (16 U.S.C. 1858–1860).

3 (2) ENFORCEMENT.—The Secretary shall en-
4 force this section as if a violation of subsection (a)
5 were a violation of section 307 of the Magnuson-Ste-
6 vens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16
7 U.S.C. 1857).

8 (c) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 90 days after
9 the date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary
10 shall issue such regulations as are necessary to carry out
11 this section.

12 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

13 (1) COVERED PERIOD.—The term “covered pe-
14 riod” means a period during which the recreational
15 harvest of South Atlantic red snapper in Federal
16 waters is prohibited.

17 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
18 the Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Di-
19 rector of the National Marine Fisheries Service.

20 (3) SOUTH ATLANTIC RED SNAPPER.—The
21 term “South Atlantic red snapper” means red snap-
22 per (*Lutjanus campechanus*) subject to management
23 under the Fishery Management Plan for the Snap-
24 per Grouper Fishery of the South Atlantic Region
