A BILL

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1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HUD Disaster Infor-
5 mation Improvement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SHARING OF DISASTER RELIEF DATA.**

2 (a) MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.—The Sec-
3 retary of Housing and Urban Development shall enter into
4 a memorandum of understanding, or other appropriate
5 interagency agreement, with the Administrator of the Fed-
6 eral Emergency Management Agency and the Adminis-
7 trator of the Small Business Administration to share rel-
8 evant disaster relief data for the purpose of increasing effi-
9 ciency and mitigating waste, fraud, and abuse across dis-
10 aster recovery programs administered by the Secretary of
11 Housing and Urban Development.

12 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
13 of enactment of this section, the Secretary of Housing and
14 Urban Development shall submit to the Committee on Fi-
15 nancial Services of the House of Representatives and the
16 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of
17 the Senate a report containing a description of opportuni-
18 ties for increased collaboration between the Department
19 of Housing and Urban Development, the Federal Emer-
20 gency Management Agency, and the Small Business Ad-
21 ministration to improve Department of Housing and
22 Urban Development efficiencies in Department of Housing
23 and Urban Development disaster recovery programs.

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
