## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8029) making appropriations for the Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 1128) expressing the support of the House

of Representatives for the Department of Homeland Security; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5103) to establish a program to Beautify the District of Columbia and establish the District of Columbia Safe and Beautiful Commission; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7084) to amend title 46, United States Code, with respect to the types of vessels that may enter or operate in navigable waters of the United States or transfer cargo in any port or place under the jurisdiction of the United States, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 8029) making appropriations for the Department of  
4 Homeland Security for the fiscal year ending September  
5 30, 2026, and for other purposes. All points of order  
6 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall  
7 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-  
8 sions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall  
9 be considered as ordered on the bill and on any amend-  
10 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
11 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-  
12 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the  
13 Committee on Appropriations or their respective des-  
14 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

15       SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
16 in order without intervention of any point of order to con-  
17 sider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 1128) express-

1 ing the support of the House of Representatives for the  
2 Department of Homeland Security. The amendments to  
3 the resolution and the preamble printed in the report of  
4 the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution  
5 shall be considered as adopted. The resolution, as amend-  
6 ed, shall be considered as read. The previous question shall  
7 be considered as ordered on the resolution and preamble,  
8 as amended, to adoption without intervening motion or de-  
9 mand for division of the question except one hour of de-  
10 bate equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-  
11 ing minority member of the Committee on Homeland Se-  
12 curity or their respective designees.

13       SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
14 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 5103)  
15 to establish a program to Beautify the District of Colum-  
16 bia and establish the District of Columbia Safe and Beau-  
17 tiful Commission. All points of order against consideration  
18 of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of  
19 a substitute recommended by the Committee on Oversight  
20 and Government Reform now printed in the bill shall be  
21 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-  
22 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in  
23 the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
24 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
25 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage

1 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
2 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
3 minority member of the Committee on Oversight and Gov-  
4 ernment Reform or their respective designees; and (2) one  
5 motion to recommit.

6       SEC. 4. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
7 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 7084)  
8 to amend title 46, United States Code, with respect to the  
9 types of vessels that may enter or operate in navigable  
10 waters of the United States or transfer cargo in any port  
11 or place under the jurisdiction of the United States, and  
12 for other purposes. All points of order against consider-  
13 ation of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature  
14 of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Trans-  
15 portation and Infrastructure now printed in the bill shall  
16 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be  
17 considered as read. All points of order against provisions  
18 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
19 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
20 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage  
21 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
22 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
23 minority member of the Committee on Transportation and  
24 Infrastructure or their respective designees; and (2) one  
25 motion to recommit.

1        SEC. 5. Section 8 of House Resolution 707, agreed  
2 to September 16, 2025, is amended by striking “March  
3 31, 2026” and inserting “the remainder of the One Hun-  
4 dred Nineteenth Congress”.
