Mr. MACKENZIE submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to restrict a recorded vote on any question put before the House after a certain hour, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This resolution may be cited as the “Protecting De-
4 liberative Process in the House Resolution”.

5 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTIONS ON RECORDED VOTES IN THE**
6 **HOUSE.**

7 Rule XXIX of the Rules of the House of Representa-
8 tives is amended by adding at the end the following new
9 clause:

1 “5. Notwithstanding any other rule of the House, no
2 recorded vote conducted pursuant to the voting procedures
3 under rule XX may be ordered on or after 11:00 p.m. on
4 any day the House is in session unless it is determined,
5 by an affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the
6 Members voting, a quorum being present, that exigent cir-
7 cumstances exist such that an exception to this require-
8 ment is warranted.”.
