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## RESOLUTION

Providing a point of order in the House of Representatives during the 119th Congress against reconciliation measures that reduce benefits under the Medicaid program or the supplemental nutrition assistance program.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. POINT OF ORDER ON CUTS TO CERTAIN PRO-**  
3                               **GRAMS IN RECONCILIATION MEASURES.**

4           (a) IN GENERAL.—During the period beginning on  
5 the date of the enactment of this resolution and ending  
6 on the last day of the 119th Congress, it shall not be in  
7 order in the House of Representatives to consider any rec-  
8 onciliation bill or reconciliation resolution reported pursu-

1 ant to a concurrent resolution on the budget agreed to  
 2 under section 301 or 304 of the Congressional Budget and  
 3 Impoundment Control Act of 1974, or a joint resolution  
 4 pursuant to section 258C of the Balanced Budget and  
 5 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, or any amend-  
 6 ment thereto or conference report thereon that—

7           (1) reduces enrollment or benefits for any indi-  
 8       vidual described in subsection (b) enrolled in the  
 9       Medicaid program under title XIX of the Social Se-  
 10      curity Act; or

11           (2) reduces eligibility or benefits for households  
 12      with individuals described in such subsection and  
 13      that participate in the supplemental nutrition assist-  
 14      ance program under the Food and Nutrition Act of  
 15      2008.

16       (b) INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED.—An individual de-  
 17      scribed in this subsection is any of the following:

18           (1) An individual under the age of 19.

19           (2) An individual age 65 or older.

20           (3) A pregnant woman.

21           (4) An individual with a disability (as that term  
 22      is defined in section 223(d) of the Social Security  
 23      Act).

24       (c) EXCEPTION.—The point of order under this sec-  
 25      tion shall not apply to any provision in a reconciliation

- 1 bill or reconciliation resolution that reduces improper pay-
- 2 ments, eliminates fraudulent billing, or enhances data
- 3 verification to ensure eligibility for applicable benefits.
