Mr. FITZPATRICK submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3001) to advance commonsense priorities.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 3001) to advance common-
4 sense priorities. All points of order against consideration
5 of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of
6 a substitute specified in section 3 of this resolution shall
7 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be
8 considered as read. All points of order against provisions
9 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question
10 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,

1 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage
2 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
3 equally divided and controlled by Representative
4 Fitzpatrick of Pennsylvania or a designee and an oppo-
5 nent; and (2) one motion to recommit.

6 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
7 the consideration of H.R. 3001.

8 SEC. 3. The amendment in the nature of a substitute
9 referred to in the first section of this resolution is an
10 amendment in the nature of a substitute received for
11 printing in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
12 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII dated
13 at least one day before the consideration of H.R. 3001,
14 if submitted by Representative Fitzpatrick of Pennsyl-
15 vania. If more than one such amendment is submitted,
16 then only the last amendment submitted shall be consid-
17 ered as adopted.

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
