Ms. ANSARI submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Establishing an advisory working group to make recommendations with respect to relief portraits in the Hall of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY WORKING**
3 **GROUP.**

4 (a) ESTABLISHMENT; COMPOSITION.—There is es-
5 tablished an advisory working group to carry out this sec-
6 tion that shall consist of the following members:

7 (1) The Clerk of the House of Representatives.

8 (2) The Curator of the House of Representa-
9 tives.

1 (3) The Curator for the Architect of the Cap-
2 itol.

3 (4) The Chair and ranking minority member of
4 the Committee on House Administration.

5 (5) The Chair and ranking minority member of
6 the Subcommittee on the Legislative Branch of the
7 Committee on Appropriations.

8 (6) The Co-Chairs of the Congressional Bipar-
9 tisan Women's Caucus.

10 (b) RESPONSIBILITIES.—The advisory working group
11 shall submit to the Speaker of the House of Representa-
12 tives, the Minority Leader, and the Committee on House
13 Administration a written report that includes rec-
14 ommendations with respect to the following:

15 (1) Two women whose portraits would be suit-
16 able for inclusion among the relief portraits of law-
17 givers placed above the doors to the public gallery of
18 the Hall of the House of Representatives.

19 (2) The planning, funding, and commissioning
20 of the relief portraits of the women described in
21 paragraph (1).

22 (3) The installation of the relief portraits de-
23 scribed in paragraph (2) in the Hall of the House
24 of Representatives, including whether the relief por-
25 traits should replace any existing relief portrait.

1 (4) A timeline for such installation that would
2 minimize the disruptive effect of the installation on
3 the business conducted in the Hall of the House of
4 Representatives.

5 (c) COORDINATION.—The advisory working group
6 shall designate two members among the individuals de-
7 scribed in paragraphs (4) through (6), with the approval
8 of the Speaker and the Minority Leader, to take such ac-
9 tions as are necessary for the advisory working group to
10 carry out this section.

11 (d) CONSULTATION WITH EXPERTS.—In carrying
12 out this section, the advisory working group shall consult
13 with the following:

14 (1) Leading and reputable scholars with respect
15 to the history of law, women’s history, and related
16 disciplines of study and research.

17 (2) Staff of the Library of Congress.

18 (e) DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION.—The advisory
19 working group shall submit the report described in sub-
20 section (b) not later than the earliest of the following:

21 (1) One year after the date of the adoption of
22 this Resolution.

23 (2) The end of the One Hundred Nineteenth
24 Congress.

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
