RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President of the United States to furnish certain information to the House of Representatives relating to the Department of Government Efficiency's access to and usage of NUMIDENT and other personally identifiable information in the possession of the Social Security Administration.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the President of the United States is
- 2 requested to furnish the House of Representatives, not
- 3 later than 14 days after the date of adoption of this reso-

1 lution, copies of any document, record, audio recording,
2 memorandum, call log, correspondence (electronic or oth-
3 erwise), audit trails and audit logs, written agreements,
4 or other communication in his possession, or any portion
5 of any document, record, audio recording, memorandum,
6 call log, correspondence (electronic or otherwise), or other
7 communication, that refers or relates to the following:

8 (1) The development of a cloud environment
9 that hosts a copy of the Social Security Administra-
10 tion’s Numerical Identification System (hereafter re-
11 ferred to as “NUMIDENT”), including risk assess-
12 ments and security protocols.

13 (2) The purpose of creating a cloud environ-
14 ment that hosts a copy of the NUMIDENT, includ-
15 ing whether the copy will be used to:

16 (A) conduct Federal audits and investiga-
17 tions;

18 (B) restrict or deny Social Security bene-
19 fits, Medicare coverage, or any other benefits;

20 (C) develop a centralized database for the
21 Federal Government that compiles citizens’ per-
22 sonal information across Federal agencies and
23 departments;

24 (D) sell or make available information con-
25 tained in the copy for private purchase; or

1 (E) train and enhance artificial intel-
2 ligence.

3 (3) Access to, and usage of, NUMIDENT infor-
4 mation hosted in such cloud environment by Edward
5 Coristine, Aram Moghaddassi, John Solly, Michael
6 Russo, or any other individual, including those act-
7 ing for or on behalf of the Department of Govern-
8 ment Efficiency (hereafter referred to as “DOGE”).

9 (4) Access to, and usage of, personally identifi-
10 able information inside the Social Security Adminis-
11 tration’s Enterprise Data Warehouse on or after
12 March 14, 2025, by Payton Rehling, Aram
13 Moghaddassi, or any other individuals acting for or
14 on behalf of DOGE.

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
