Mr. MCGOVERN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1834) to advance policy priorities that will break the gridlock.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 1834) to advance policy prior-
4 ities that will break the gridlock. All points of order
5 against consideration of the bill are waived. An amend-
6 ment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text
7 of H.R. 5450, as introduced, shall be considered as adopt-
8 ed. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All
9 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,
10 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as

1 ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
2 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening
3 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
4 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
5 the Committee on Appropriations or their respective des-
6 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

7 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
8 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 1834.

9 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
10 sage that the House has passed H.R. 1834 no later than
11 one calendar day after passage.

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
