A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify that the Department of Veterans Affairs definition of “medical services” includes medically necessary automobile adaptations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Automotive Support
5 Services to Improve Safe Transportation Act of 2025” or
6 the “ASSIST Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION REGARDING INCLUSION OF MEDI-**
 2 **CALLY NECESSARY AUTOMOBILE ADAPTA-**
 3 **TIONS IN DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**
 4 **FAIRS DEFINITION OF “MEDICAL SERVICES”.**

5 Section 1701(6)(I) of title 38, United States Code,
 6 is amended to read as follows:

7 “(I) The provision of any medically necessary
 8 automobile adaptations for driver or passenger use,
 9 including—

10 “(i) ramp and kneeling systems;

11 “(ii) raised doors or lowered floors;

12 “(iii) raised roofs;

13 “(iv) air conditioning;

14 “(v) occupied and unoccupied mobility
 15 lifts;

16 “(vi) ingress or egress accessibility modi-
 17 fications;

18 “(vii) wheelchair tiedowns; and

19 “(viii) adapted seating.”.

20 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN LIMITS ON PAYMENTS OF**
 21 **PENSION.**

22 Section 5503(d)(7) of title 38, United States Code,
 23 is amended by striking “November 30, 2031” and insert-
 24 ing “September 30, 2032”.
