A BILL

To modify the provision of law on expedited review of export licenses for exports of advanced technologies to Australia, the United Kingdom, and Canada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF EXPEDITED REVIEW OF EX-**
4 **PORT LICENSES FOR EXPORTS OF ADVANCED**
5 **TECHNOLOGIES TO AUSTRALIA, THE UNITED**
6 **KINGDOM, AND CANADA.**

7 Section 1344 of the National Defense Authorization
8 Act for Fiscal Year 2024 (22 U.S.C. 10423) is amended
9 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(d) EXPORT DEFINED.—In this section, the term
2 ‘export’ includes, and applies with respect to, all transfers
3 of defense articles and defense services described in sub-
4 section (a), including reexports, retransfers, third party
5 transfers, temporary imports, and brokering activities of
6 such articles and services.”.
