A BILL

To appropriate amounts to the Disaster Relief Fund of the
Federal Emergency Management Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Disaster
5 Relief Fund Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISASTER RELIEF FUND.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—There is appropriated, out of
8 amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
9 \$25,000,000,000 for fiscal year 2025 to the Administrator
10 of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the ac-

1 count entitled “Federal Emergency Management Adminis-
2 tration—Disaster Relief Fund”.

3 (b) EMERGENCY DESIGNATION.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amounts provided by
5 this Act are designated as an emergency require-
6 ment pursuant to section 4(g) of the Statutory Pay-
7 As-You-Go Act of 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

8 (2) DESIGNATION IN HOUSE AND SENATE.—

9 This Act is designated as being for an emergency re-
10 quirement pursuant to section 4001(a)(1) of S. Con.
11 Res. 14 (117th Congress), the concurrent resolution
12 on the budget for fiscal year 2022, and to legislation
13 establishing fiscal year 2025 budget enforcement in
14 the House of Representatives.

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
