## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide for electronic communication relating to educational assistance benefits under the laws administered by the Secretary, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Delivering Digitally  
5 to Our Veterans Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ELECTRONIC**  
2 **COMMUNICATION RELATING TO EDU-**  
3 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE BENEFITS.**

4 Section 3680 of title 38, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
6 section:

7 “(i) ELECTRONIC CORRESPONDENCE.—(1) The Sec-  
8 retary shall provide a mechanism by which an eligible vet-  
9 eran or eligible person may electronically send and receive  
10 correspondence with the Department of Veterans Affairs  
11 relating to entitlement to and use of educational assistance  
12 benefits under the laws administered by the Secretary.  
13 The Secretary shall ensure that an eligible veteran or eligi-  
14 ble person is provided with an opportunity to opt into  
15 sending and receiving such correspondence electronically  
16 rather than by mail.

17 “(2) The Secretary shall provide to eligible veterans  
18 and eligible persons who are enrolled in a course or pro-  
19 gram of education or training notice of the opportunity  
20 to opt in to sending and receiving correspondence elec-  
21 tronically pursuant to paragraph (1).”.
