A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining American
3 Manufacturing Strategy Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. ALIGNMENT OF TIMING OF UPDATES OF STRA-**
5 **TEGIC PLAN WITH UPDATES TO NATIONAL**
6 **STRATEGY FOR ADVANCED MANUFAC-**
7 **TURING.**

8 Section 34(i)(2) of the National Institute of Stand-
9 ards and Technology Act (15 U.S.C. 278s(i)(2)) is amend-
10 ed—

11 (1) in subparagraph (C), by striking “and up-
12 date not less frequently than once every 3 years
13 thereafter,”;

14 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (D)
15 through (M) as subparagraphs (E) through (N), re-
16 spectively; and

17 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (C), the fol-
18 lowing:

19 “(D) to update the strategic plan devel-
20 oped under subparagraph (C) not less fre-
21 quently than once every 4 years and such that
22 the planning cycle for the updates aligns with
23 the planning cycle for updates to the National
24 Strategy for Advanced Manufacturing required
25 under section 102(e)(4) of the America COM-
26 PETES Reauthorization Act of 2010 (42

6 *(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Such section is fur-*
 7 *ther amended—*

8 *(1) in paragraph (3), by striking “paragraph*
 9 *(2)(C)” and inserting “subparagraphs (C) and (D) of*
 10 *paragraph (2)”;* and

11 *(2) in paragraph (4), by striking “paragraph*
 12 *(2)(C)” and inserting “subparagraph (C) of para-*
 13 *graph (2) and any update to the plan required under*
 14 *subparagraph (D) of such paragraph”.*
