1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY FOR**
2 **MEMORIAL ESTABLISHMENT.**

3 Section 1(b) of Public Law 115–275 (132 Stat. 4164;
4 40 U.S.C. 8903 note) is amended by striking the period
5 at the end and inserting “, except that any reference in
6 section 8903(e) of that title to the expiration at the end
7 of, or extension beyond, a 7-year period shall be considered
8 to be a reference to an expiration on, or extension beyond,
9 November 3, 2032.”.

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
