## A BILL

To terminate the exemption from numerical limitations for  
H-1B nonimmigrants employed by institutions of higher  
education.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Colleges for the Amer-  
5       ican People Act of 2025” or the “CAP Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF EXEMPTION FROM NUMERICAL**  
2 **LIMITATIONS FOR H-1B NONIMMIGRANTS**  
3 **EMPLOYED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER**  
4 **EDUCATION.**

5 Section 214(g)(5) of the Immigration and Nationality  
6 Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(g)(5)) is amended—

- 7 (1) by striking subparagraph (A); and  
8 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and  
9 (C) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively.
