A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, regarding additional assessments on convicted persons, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Enduring Justice for
5 Victims of Trafficking Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS.**

7 Section 3014(a) of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended by striking “Beginning on the date of enactment
9 of the Justice for Victims of Trafficking Act of 2015 and
10 ending on September 30, 2025, in addition to the assess-

1 ment imposed under section 3013, the court shall assess
2 an amount of \$5,000 on any non-indigent person or entity
3 convicted of an offense under—” and inserting “In addi-
4 tion to the assessment imposed under section 3013, the
5 court shall assess an amount of \$5,000 on any non-indi-
6 gent person or entity convicted of an offense under—”.

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
