A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Transportation from establishing new performance measures or regulatory or program requirements relating to highway safety grant programs, to require the Secretary of Transportation to ease certain requirements relating to those programs, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safety Grant Consist-
5 ency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO**
2 **HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT PROGRAMS.**

3 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT PROGRAMS.—The
5 term “highway safety grant programs” means the
6 programs under sections 402 and 405 of title 23,
7 United States Code.

8 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
9 the Secretary of Transportation.

10 (b) PROHIBITIONS; REQUIREMENTS.—Notwith-
11 standing any other provision of law, the Secretary—

12 (1) may not establish new performance meas-
13 ures or regulatory or program requirements relating
14 to the highway safety grant programs not in effect
15 before the date of enactment of this Act; and

16 (2) shall ease or eliminate any requirement re-
17 lating to the highway safety grant programs not ex-
18 plicitly authorized or required by an Act of Con-
19 gress.

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
