Mr. GRASSLEY (for himself and Mr. LUJÁN) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage under the Medicare program of pharmacist services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pharmacy and Medi-
5 cally Underserved Areas Enhancement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF PHARMACIST SERVICES.**

7 (a) COVERAGE.—Section 1861(s)(2) of the Social Se-
8 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (JJ), by inserting “and”
10 at the end; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(KK) pharmacist services furnished by a phar-
4 macist, as licensed by State law, individually or on
5 behalf of a pharmacy provider—

6 “(i) which the pharmacist is legally author-
7 ized to perform in the State in which the indi-
8 vidual performs such services;

9 “(ii) as would otherwise be covered under
10 this part if furnished by a physician, or as an
11 incident to a physician’s service; and

12 “(iii) in a setting located in a health pro-
13 fessional shortage area (as defined in section
14 332(a)(1)(A) of the Public Health Service Act),
15 medically underserved area, or medically under-
16 served population (as defined in section
17 330(b)(3) of such Act);”.

18 (b) PAYMENT.—Section 1833(a)(1) of the Social Se-
19 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(a)(1)) is amended—

20 (1) by striking “and (HH)” and inserting
21 “(HH)”; and

22 (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end
23 the following: “, and (II) with respect to pharmacist
24 services (as defined in section 1861(s)(2)(KK)), the
25 amounts paid shall be equal to 80 percent of the

1 lesser of the actual charge or 85 percent of the fee
2 schedule amount provided under section 1848 if
3 such services had been furnished by a physician”.

4 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE; PHARMACIST SPECIFIC
5 CODES.—

6 (1) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made
7 by subsections (a) and (b) shall apply with respect
8 to services furnished on or after January 1, 2027.

9 (2) PHARMACIST SPECIFIC CODES.—The Sec-
10 retary of Health and Human Services shall develop
11 pharmacist specific codes, as necessary, under the
12 physician fee schedule under section 1848 of the So-
13 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–4).

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
