Mr. BLUMENTHAL introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Valent Kolami.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR VALENT**
4 **KOLAMI.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Valent Kolami shall be eligible for
8 issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status
9 to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi-
10 dence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi-
11 grant visa under section 204 of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1154)
12 or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Valent Kolami en-
2 ters the United States before the filing deadline specified
3 in subsection (c), Valent Kolami shall be considered to
4 have entered and remained lawfully in the United States
5 and shall be eligible for adjustment of status under section
6 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
7 1255) as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

8 (c) APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Sub-
9 sections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for
10 the issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for
11 adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees not
12 later than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this
13 Act.

14 (d) PAYGO.—The budgetary effects of this Act, for
15 the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-
16 Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the
17 latest statement titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO
18 Legislation” for this Act, submitted for printing in the
19 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the Senate
20 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been
21 submitted prior to the vote on passage.

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
